Irthlingborough Town Councils agreed priorities for the next 12 months

- To request permission from the owner of the Select & Save site on the High Street to place a hoarding in front of the building to be commissioned by a local artist Mark Pacan. The schools within Irthlingborough to be approached for design ideas. The hoarding to be painted to make the High Street look more attractive, with the design chosen by the community.
Agreed to investigate the costs of a free-standing hoarding 8-foot-tall and a fixed hoarding both with an access door to the site for the owner.
- To improve the appearance of the High Street by painting seats, and increasing flowers and planting, weeding and make the area look more attractive.
- Consider planting flower beds in the Rest Gardens and Parsons Green.
- To look at planters to be placed at each Town sign on the four entrances to the Town.
- To consider decorating the Town for National Anniversaries
- To improve lighting in the Alleyway next to the Rest Gardens and invest in vandal proof lights to give residents the confidence to go out.
- To improve community engagement between the Town and the Council by setting up a Town Council Facebook Page which would link to the current web page and twitter account.
- All councillors agreed to look at their profiles on the existing Town Council website and update them or write the ones that are missing. Email will be sent to the rest of the council to remind them to.
